

Puppy Diet Sheet

The following is just a guide and may need to alter as pups needs change.

Your Puppy is currently on 4 meals a day I recommend she stays on 4 meals until she is 4 months of age . By the time she is six months she can then go onto two meals a day. I strongly recommend she remains on two meals throughout her adult life.

6:30 – 7:30 am 90 g of Royal Canin Maxi Puppy soaked in warm water so slightly mushy with a handful of raw green tripe or raw mince beef (lean) mixed in

12:30 – 13:30. 90 g of Royal Canin Maxi Puppy soaked in warm water so slightly mushy with a handful of raw green tripe or raw mince beef (lean) mixed in

16:30-17:30pm . 90 g of Royal Canin Maxi Puppy soaked in warm water so slightly mushy with a handful of raw green tripe or raw mince beef (lean) mixed in

22:30 – 23:30pm. 90 g of Royal Canin Maxi Puppy soaked in warm water so slightly mushy with a handful of raw green tripe or raw mince beef (lean) mixed in

I normally give a small warm drink of full fat Goats Milk after Breakfast and supper (**never give cows milk !**)

Never leave your pup too long without food, often if the stomach does not have anything to work on and the pup is hungry they can vomit and bring up bile or the vomit is non- productive. This is something to watch out for when reducing meals.

Your Puppy should always look a little plump when young, and exercise should be kept to a minimum, the rule of thumb is 5 mins exercise for every month of life daily this includes running around the garden. **Great care should be taken that your pup is not repeatedly jumping down off high steps or stairs / sofas for the first 6 months of life, this can cause permanent damage and deformity to the bones and joints.**
